2023-2024 Biderman Scholarship Application

The Lutheran Church of the Resurrection Living Legacy Committee announces scholarships for graduating high school seniors enrolled at an accredited college, university, or vocational/technical school. The committee will award scholarships based upon qualified applicants, number of applications, and funds available. The rules and instructions below should clarify any questions regarding qualification for the scholarships. Questions should be directed to the Living Legacy Fund at trustfund@lcrmarion.org

SCHOLARSHIP RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The applicant shall be a graduating high school senior in the 2022-2023 academic year.
- 2. The recipient shall be a student accepted (or applied) for the 2023-2024 academic year in an undergraduate course of study at an accredited college, university, or vocational/technical school as at least a half-time student.
- 3. The applicant shall be a confirmed member/member by affirmation of Lutheran Church of the Resurrection.
- 4. The applicant shall have attended at minimum 12 worship activities at LCR in the 12 months prior to the application date (in person or virtual as self-verified).
- 5. The applicant shall demonstrate involvement in ministry and/or discipleship activities in the 12 months prior to the application date (a minimum of 5 hours). This can include volunteering to assist with church activities as well as involvement in community outreach activities. See application for more details.
- 6. All applications shall be completed in full and be postmarked or emailed on or before March 20, 2023. All applicants will be notified of the results by April 20, 2023. A valid email address is required.
- 7. For students enrolled in a school participating in the EPIC program, scholarship checks will be sent directly to the financial office of the educational institution. Otherwise, the scholarship check will be mailed to the student's home address upon receipt of tuition payment documentation.
- 8. Scholarships shall be paid in two equal installments (September and January).
- 9. All information supplied by the applicants shall be considered confidential.
- 10. All submissions become the property of the LCR Living Legacy Fund.
